BANKS BBQ Combine Demolition Derby Regulations

- 1. Pickup reel or bat reel removed.
- 2. Cutting bar removed.
- 3. Crop dividers removed.
- 4. Glass removed from Cabs.
- 5. Install seat belts.
- 6. Crash helmets required.
- 7. Original fuel tank removed (5 Gal. limit install in grain tank).
- 8. Rubber tires only, no fluid or foam in tires.
- 9. Straw choppers removed.
- 10. Header height 16-18 inches (fixed solid).
- 11. Unloading auger within 10 inches.
- 12. Rub bars can be placed around the radiator for protection.
- 13. Protection around variable speed acceptable.
- 14. All chains and belts removed that are not used for forward and reverse motion.
- 15. Disabled flag mounted 3 feet above grain tank.
- 16. For safety any number of iron pieces can be used.
- 17. Rear axle cannot be narrowed less than straw walkers unless factory option.
- 18. All combines need to be inspected and approved before entry by judges.
- 19. Hillside combines must be fixed solid.
- 20. Combines are only intended to last a 15-minute heat. Over reinforcement will only delay and lengthen the action, which will only lose the audience's interest. Reinforcement is subject to judges' decision, call and as if in doubt.
- 21. The drivers' area must have sufficient protection without limiting drivers' visibility.
- 22. Driver protection: An approved crash helmet, 2000 snell spec or newer with chin strap is required. Eye protection in the form of goggles or safety glasses is required for any helmet not having a fully functional face shield. A fire-retardant suit is highly recommended. At a minimum long pants and long sleeve shirts should be worn. Sturdy boots are recommended over tennis shoes or sneaker type footwear to provide foot and ankle protection.
